COLLEGE OF APPLIED HEALTH SCIENCES- BIOMEDICAL VISUALIZATION CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE FALL 2017

Students are required to:

- Meet all requirements for the intended year of entry into the graduate program. Admission requirements may change after you enter UIC. Students are responsible for consulting with a BVIS advisor in order to stay abreast of any changes in admission requirements that may occur;
- Complete all prerequisite course work at UIC;
- Maintain a 3.5 GPA (A=4.0) each semester. This cumulative GPA will be reviewed at the end of each semester and again at the conclusion of the semester prior to the anticipated entrance into the graduate program;
- Complete all BVIS prerequisite courses with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.3;
- Maintain a full-time course load each semester (a minimum of 12 semester hours);
- Review academic progress with an advisor in the Biomedical Visualization graduate program once per semester;
- Enroll in the Honors College and fulfill all requirements for continued membership each term:
- Complete a B.S. or B.A. degree by the term of entry into the M.S. program;
- Obtain a minimum GRE combined Quantitative and Verbal score of 300; and
- Enroll in the Biomedical Visualization M.S. Program during the year of acceptance.

Upon satisfactory completion of all program requirements, a seat in the Biomedical Visualization, Master's degree program (M.S.) will be reserved.
