During the freshman and sophomore years of study at UIC College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, the admitted GPPA student must:

1. Satisfy the following prerequisite course requirements for admission to the upper-division nursing

2. Enroll in the Honors College and fulfill all requirements for continued membership each term, including minimum grade point average.
3. Maintain a full-time (minimum 12 semester hours) course load during each semester.
4. Maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.40 (A = 4.00). If your cumulative GPA falls below a 3.4 you will receive a warning letter. If your cumulative GPA falls below a 3.4 a second time, you will be reviewed by the College of Nursing committee for possible dismissal.
5. Meet once a term with your Honors College advisor and the College of Nursing Undergraduate Coordinator.
6. Meet with your Honors College fellow beginning your sophomore year.



7. Attend 2 College of Nursing events per year: i.e. the Cultural Workshop in the fall term and Research Day in the spring term.
8. Volunteer for at least 3 College of Nursing and/or UHP (Urban Health Program) sponsored events per year.
9. Serve as a mentor to freshman and sophomore GPPA students during your junior and senior years.
10. Adhere to the 2017 General Conditions of Acceptance.
