CONDITIONS OF ACCEPTANCE FALL 2014**

During the freshman and sophomore years of study at UIC College of Liberal Arts and Sciences, the admitted GPPA student must:

1. Satisfy the following prerequisite course requirements for admission to the upper-division nursing program.

2. Enroll in the Honors College and fulfill all requirements for continued membership each term, including minimum grade point average.

3. Maintain a full-time (minimum 12 semester hours) course load during each semester.

4. Maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.40 (A = 4.00). If your cumulative GPA falls below a 3.4 you will receive a warning letter. If your cumulative GPA falls below a 3.4 a second time, you will be reviewed by the College of Nursing committee for possible dismissal.

5. Meet once a term with your Honors College advisor and the College of Nursing Undergraduate Coordinator.

6. Meet with your Honors College fellow beginning your sophomore year.

7. Participate in two College of Nursing events per year: the Cultural Workshop in the fall term and Research Day in the spring term.

8. Volunteer for at least three College of Nursing and/or UHP (Urban Health Program) sponsored events per year.

9. Serve as a mentor to freshman and sophomore GPPA students during your junior and senior years as well as a mentee freshman and sophomore years.

10. Students must adhere to the 2014 General Conditions of Acceptance.
