Conditions of Acceptance and Continued Participation in GPPA:

**Undergraduate Curriculum**

Any undergraduate major is acceptable.

**Additional Requirements**

Although no specific courses are required for GPPA participation, CUPPA encourages students who are not CUPPA undergraduate students to take courses in the College in either the Public Policy or Urban Studies baccalaureate degree program.

Students must enroll in the Honors College and fulfill all requirements for continued membership each term.

Students must maintain full-time student status of at least 12 credit hours each term.

Students must maintain a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.4 (A=4.00) throughout their undergraduate years.

Students must complete the GRE by January of the year prior to matriculation into the master's program of their choice if they are interested in being considered for financial assistance as a graduate student.

Students must complete Honors College Capstone requirement with a faculty member from CUPPA (unless another mentor is approved). CUPPA Capstone requirements will satisfy the Honors College requirement.

In the final year of undergraduate work, students complete a statement of professional intent and submit 3 letters of recommendation for the master's program of their choice to reserve a seat upon graduation from UIC.

Students must adhere to the General Conditions of Acceptance for students of all GPPA programs entering in the year that they are admitted to the program.
